

Five-Fold Ministries

"I want my wheel, moving in My church. I'm the wheel inside of the wheel. The five spokes that hold the wheel in place are My five-fold ministries that I have chosen. The mortar represents what God has sitting, waiting to be used. Macaroni are man-made perishable things. The movement of the elbow means to remove or to shove out of the way. These things in the foundation of the church that are man-made are not eternal. That is an area in the church that God wants to remove. When this act of obedience is done, then God is going to show up like He has never shown up before. As long as these hindrances are in place, they need to be removed and replaced with what God has ordained and anointed to be there.
