of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? For we know him that hath said, Vengeance *belonged* unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. *It is* a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye endured a great fight of afflictions; partly, whilst ye were made a gazing stock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used.”

Some Christians have not been able to get off milk. Strong meat belongs to the mature brother. We still have pastors who are on milk and who are afraid to step forward to give a full meal. If the pastors don't grow, then we do not grow. And that body withers away, and spiritually fasting is not biblical. If your spirit is not fed then you spiritually die. Then sheep go and jump fence real quick. They eat off some good healthy grass. Then they jump back a little, fed and refreshed. They act like everything is fine, but if you look in the spirit, you will see these sheep withering away. It all stems from much talking; preachers with many words but no substance. Sheep feel like they owe that ministry or man so they are afraid to get real food because they have been condemned and shackled by soul ties. We begin to put on grave clothes. We are under the control of man with these feelings. This is witchcraft from within the church, and God does not approve of it. "Those who are not on fire, shut down your church, and let my people go," says the Lord. Every Sunday we go to church. We have made such a tradition out of it. This should be a place for celebration. God never called church to be a preaching center for one man--every week to go up front, talk about what God is doing, not doing, every week. Paul clearly said, "Prophecy one to another." Fellowship together, share testimonies. You as a leader think people want to hear you every week. Believe me, Man and Woman of God, you don't have enough in yourself to continue to feed the sheep. The pulpit is not yours. This is not freedom. This is bondage. The pulpit is Christ's. He is the head of the Church. If He wants His arm up there that day, so be it; maybe His ear one day. Well, God is crying out to release His people, His gifts. We must continue to be reformed, but most leaders have a pride issue or a fear issue. That's when the devil comes to destroy, to bring division. The people are not free, but we will say we are free here. Do some of them really think they are free? They don't know what freedom is.
