A Word to all the prophets

Matthew 5:8: 8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

On behalf of the Body of Christ, I write this letter to all the prophets and seers.

I really pray that these Words will produce live inside of you, and there will not be offense or rejection. May your hearts get low with humility so that you will listen to what the Lord is saying to you, men and women of God.

What was at first just a simple observation became a message. The Lord used what was on T.V. about Travon – the teenager that was killed – to show me how the media was putting fire in the pit to provoke more anger in the black community, but He did not stop there. He showed me that His prophets have been trapped in the same way. The media has twisted their heads and changed their hearts.

THE NEWS AS A WEAPON: The Lord wants to bring His true prophets to the real fountains of Truth. Internet, T.V., newspapers are not and never will be a secure fountain from where they can drink. Avoid it, avoid it, avoid it! Go back where you were before and drink from His living waters! The NEWS is like a little FOX destroying the vine. It may be truth what they say, but their words are being used to stir up anger among God's prophets. The truth is being used as a weapon to contaminate God's messenger. Be aware of it.

WICKED GOVERNMENT: Yes, but it will always be this way because the system is corrupt, and there is no mixing of Godly principles and worldly principles. He gave this government to Satan but just for a little while. We know that! Why are we so shocked about the wicked? It is in the Bible. We cannot expect the wicked to act righteously. It will never happen. Sinners sin. And this kingdom, this government, is not His!

Loving them does not mean that we agree with what they do or say, but it means that we will guard our hearts. This is a decision that needs to be made urgently. We have to keep our hearts pure towards people. Period. Especially towards those who are in authority. God reminded me about David and Saul! Oh, how we need the heart of David beating within us!

PROPHETS ON THE WALL: God was showing me that we need to have Samuel's heart. Imagine if as a prophet he had refused to anoint Saul! He was just a messenger! He knew God's plan for Israel. He knew the wickedness of Saul's heart, but He knew it was just a matter of time, and He knew his place. He was

just God's mouthpiece. The rest of his entire being was dead: his opinions, his reactions, his righteousness. A true prophet of God has to be totally empty of himself.

The problem with many prophets today is that they let their hearts be contaminated. They know the Truth. They have great revelation of the end-times, but they are missing the main point: to keep the purity of their hearts. Our main goal is not just to know the Truth but to walk in mercy and humility. That is the hardest battle: to keep on loving even the wicked one.

LOVE YOUR ENEMIES: God has shown me that most of us are failing in the test of love. He is expecting us to love even those who are being ruled by the anti-Christ spirit that is already among us. Revenge belongs to Him, and He is the One who will deal with them, righteously. Do you realize that even when the persecution hits our doors, when they come to stone us, OUR HEARTS WILL HAVE TO BE PURE and without anything against them? That's why we HAVE TO avoid any kind of discussion that stirs ANGER inside us even though many call it "righteous anger," but if you look at their fruits, their hearts are already contaminated. God is preparing us to face His enemies with great love in our eyes. Our hearts have to be pure regardless of what we see. There are true prophets out there speaking the Truth, but only a few have their hearts right with God. Even though they are exposing lies, there is mixture and compromise in the house of God. Their message has been mixed with their own feelings and self-righteousness towards the matter. They are ready to die for Jesus, but what is killing their full destiny as men and women of God are their very own hearts. If the messenger is not pure, the message never will be.

TRUTH & MERCY: Seers see ahead. They speak the unspoken and are hardly understood because they speak of spiritual things. Truth is their bread. They are like beacons shining their lights with the Truth of the Word of God over this ocean of darkness and lies. Dealing with the Truth is not easy because truth is like a double-edged sword! It will cut through, separating right and wrong. Now if you live by the sword, you will die by the sword. When the prophet speaks, He is the first one to be judged. Will your heart remain spotless when the Lord brings forth judgment? What is your reaction when wickedness is exposed? Here is the challenge of every prophet: It is no longer to speak the Truth with boldness but to not allow your heart to waver! That will take a lot of humbleness and humility! Knowledge and revelation are not what will keep you in right standing with God. Love will. Truth and mercy walk together. They are INSEPARABLE best friends. We should hold their hands tightly.

PRAY FOR THE ENEMIES: How can we pray for somebody whom we hate? We say, "I don't hate him," but we do. How can we prophecy? How can we be like Samuel and not get in the way of God? How can we be a prophet and speak in the name of God when our hearts are not pure?

If we want to obey the Word and pray for our authorities, we first need to pray for ourselves and repent. We must ask the Lord to teach us how to be a prophet like Samuel because things will get tough, and what will count is our walk of love and not our level of revelation or boldness. We will not be known by His disciples/servants/prophets/leader but by one thing: LOVE.

God has so much concern about President Obama's life that he has put him on the spot. He is exposing his heart, his lies, and his family, for what? So we can see and pray for Him. It's all part of His plan. Now His perfect plan will be accomplished when Jesus comes back. How can His is love be so strong? Guess what: if there is a next, it's not going to be different. Until Jesus returns.

The Lord says: Redeem the time because the days are evil. No time to waste. The prophets of God urgently need to spend more time before the throne of God, getting holy counseling, holy points of view, and righteous perspectives. It's time to go back to the vine, abide in Him and bear fruits that will remain. Not getting, "THUS SAYS THE LORD," from YouTube videos, facebook discussions, or the news. We are doing what our filthy righteousness is telling us not what the Word tells us. We can know more about what's going on through the Word of knowledge given by the Holy Spirit than all the news combined. Plus: The Holy Spirit will never use anything to contaminate our hearts. He is so pure!

PROPHECYING ALONE: God showed me that many are prophesying alone. They are following the "righteousness" of their own hearts, but many believe they are doing the right thing. Until now. We need to stop this madness and go back to the purity of the messenger of the old time. Many "Sauls" will come until He returns. Right now, God is not dealing with them — President Obama, Joel Osteen, Rick Warren, Al Sharpton, or others - but with the prophets that He has set as seers over nations. A lot of discussion online is being used to stir up vanity and pride inside of you. Avoid them!

JONAH & SAMUEL: What kind prophet are you? First, let's take a look at the attitude of Jonah as prophet. I will not focus on his disobedience, but I will focus on the attitude of the MESSENGER toward the MESSAGE. Look at this passage: **Jonah 4:5:** "So **Jonah** went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a booth, and sat under it in the shadow, till he might see what would become of the city." 100,000 people were at stake. Jonah set out expecting God to destroy them. See? He was acting as the judge. According to His heart, death was what they deserved. His heart was not pure at all. Did he finally obey the Word of the Lord? Yes. Did he have his heart pure? No. So, what is the point?

Jonah 4:4-6: "and I, should not I have pity on Nineveh, the great city, wherein are more than a hundred and twenty thousand persons that cannot discern between their right hand and their left hand; and also much cattle?"

They are many people out there sitting on their coaches watching T.V. wishing that something bad would happen to President Obama (and this applies to any other leader or spiritual authority), and the Lord is saying: he doesn't know what he is doing. Jesus is saying: Lord, forgive them because they don't know what they are doing. Wisdom is crying out in the corner: Purity, purity, purity!

Many of you are being attacked and you think it is the devil or you think that it is the price you have to pay for being an oracle of god but it is not.

Jonah 4:8: "And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, It is better for me to die than to live."

It is God catching your attention so that you can repent because he wants to use you, and the Body of Christ needs you with a pure heart and clean hands.

Now let's take a look at Samuel at prophet. He was the first of his kind among the nation of Israel, just like John the Baptist who fearlessly spoke the words of God without regard to his personal image, reputation or self-righteousness. Samuel had an unwavering reaction towards his calling!

First of all, the people wanted a king (or president, or a Christian leader): I Samuel 8:

¹⁹ But the people refused to listen to Samuel. "No!" they said. "We want a king over us. ²⁰ Then we will be like all the other nations, with a king to lead us and to go out before us and fight our battles." ²¹ When Samuel heard all that the people said, he repeated it before the LORD. ²² The LORD answered, "Listen to them and give them a king."

Did you read that? People refused to listen to Samuel. Samuel was so emptied of himself that he did not repay, get angry or offended. I see him as a dead prophet: dead to himself. Totally spiritually minded! Guess what happened next?

I Samuel 9:15: "Now the day before Saul came, the LORD had revealed this to Samuel: ¹⁶ "About this time tomorrow I will send you a man from the land of Benjamin. Anoint him ruler over my people Israel; he will deliver them from the hand of the Philistines. I have looked on my people, for their cry has reached me."

And he did it. Despite his "rejection," He did it. It was not about himself. People ignored Samuel completely as a seer, but he was not moved. He did exactly what the Lord told him to do. No questions asked. No feelings hurt. No mixture in the message. How did he do it? Everything starts at the beginning: he was brought before the Lord and never left the Temple. He dwelt in the presence of God.

Do you see the difference between Jonah and Samuel? What kind of prophet are you?

Listen: To the one who is like Samuel, the Lord is saying: "So Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground. And all Israel from Dan to Beersheba knew that Samuel had been established as a prophet of the LORD." (I Samuel 3:19-20)

Your anointing does not guarantee that your words will not fall to the ground, but your purity will. We need you, Prophets of God. We need to see what you see. We need to hear what you hear. We need to follow your leading. Most of all, we need your holiness. We need to drink from clean waters. Without purity, you are useless for the Kingdom of God and for His Body! Time is short: We, as the members of this Body, urge you to seek holiness.
