Song of Solomon 4:9: You have ravished my heart and given me courage, my sister, my promised bride; you have ravished my heart and given me courage with one look from your eye, with one chain of your neck.

Now, we see Him calling us friend and bride. What a beautiful relationship we have in Him. Look. Me, Marlene, with all my betrayals, with all my bad behavior, with my weak love, have ravished His heart.

Song of Solomon 4:10: How fair is your love, my sister, my bride! How much better is your love than wine! And the fragrance of your ointments than all spices!
